May 8 – Educational/Media Night – We will be finishing up *The Essential Church*. The movie was wonderful. It is so enlightening; and popcorn!

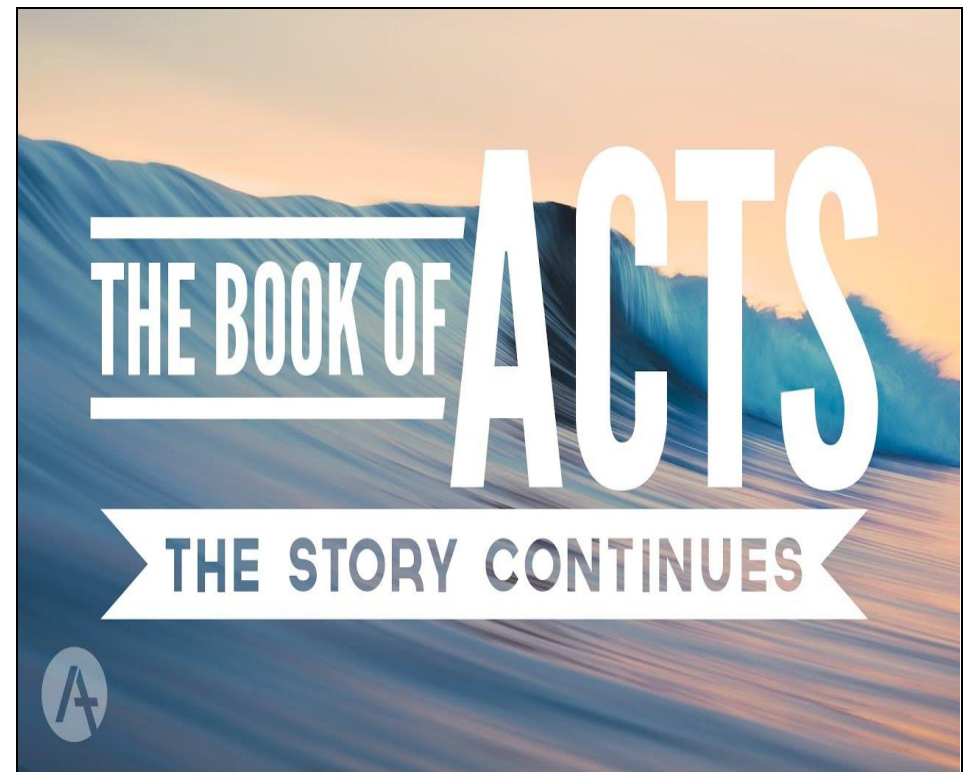
May 12 – Communion Sunday - Please contact Preston or a Consistory member if you cannot come to church for the service and would like communion at your home.

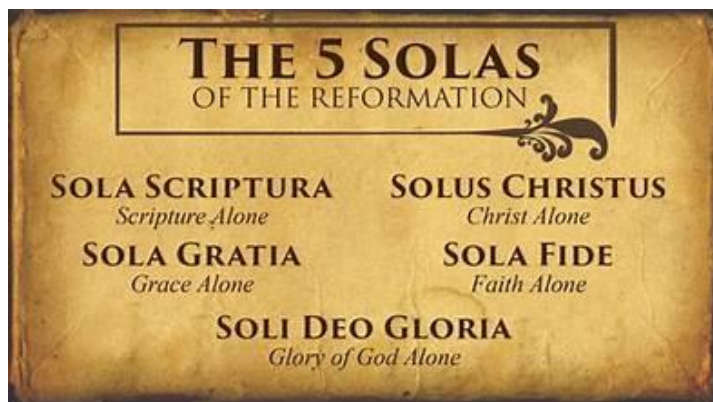
